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PRINCIPAL ONE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT REGULAR BOARD MEETING NOVEMBER 16, 2022

A. CALL TO ORDER

District Manager Jason Pierman called the November 16, 2022, Regular Board Meeting of the Principal One Community Development District (the "District") to order at 8:33 p.m. in the Clubhouse of Il Villagio located at 9745 Touchton Road, Jacksonville, Florida 32246.

B. PROOF OF PUBLICATION

Mr. Pierman presented proof of publication that notice of the Regular Board Meeting had been published in the *Jacksonville Daily Record* on September 22, 2022, as part of the District's Fiscal Year 2022/2023 Meeting Schedule, as legally required.

C. CONSIDER RESIGNATIONS

A **motion** was made by Mr. Hepke, seconded by Mrs. Hepke and passed unanimously accepting the resignations of Mike Chevalier and Ilona Macy.

D. CONSIDER APPOINTMENT OF NEW BOARD MEMBERS

A **motion** was made by Mrs. Hepke, seconded by Mr. Hepke and unanimously passed appointing Victoria Shirk to the vacant Seat 1, which expires in 2026.

A second **motion** was made by Mrs. Hepke, seconded by Mr. Hepke and unanimously passed ratifying the actions taken by the Board prior to the establishment of a quorum.
