#### PRINCIPAL ONE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT REGULAR BOARD MEETING NOVEMBER 6, 2024

#### A. CALL TO ORDER

District Manager Jason Pierman called the November 6, 2024, Regular Board Meeting of the Principal One Community Development District (the "District") to order at 6:08 p.m. in the Clubhouse of Il Villagio located at 9745 Touchton Road, Jacksonville, Florida 32246.

#### B. PROOF OF PUBLICATION

Mr. Pierman presented proof of publication that notice of the Regular Board Meeting had been published in the *Jacksonville Daily Record* on September 19, 2024, as part of the District's Fiscal Year 2024/2025 Meeting Schedule, as legally required.

#### C. CONSIDER RESIGNATION AND APPOINTMENT TO BOARD VACANCY

Mr. Pierman explained that, with the resignations of Michelle and Brian Hepke, Mr. Maymi is the sole remaining Board Member.

Mr. Maymi unanimously accepted Mr. and Mrs. Hepke's resignations and appointed Mr. Joe Cruise to the vacant Seat 3, which expires in 2026. Mr. Pierman, a Notary for the State of Florida, administered the Oath of Office to Mr. Cruise, and explained the role of District Supervisor.

A **motion** was then made by Mr. Maymi, seconded by Mr. Cruise and unanimously passed appointing Ms. Dyanna Jordan to the vacant Seat 2, which expires in 2024. Mr. Pierman administered the Oath of Office to Ms. Jordan and explained the role of District Supervisor.

With a quorum now established, a **motion** was made by Mr. Maymi, seconded by Ms. Jordan, and unanimously passed ratifying all actions taken by the Board prior to a quorum being established.

A **motion** was made by Mr. Maymi, seconded by Ms. Jordan, and unanimously passed appointing Mr. Ryan Hagen to the vacant Seat 4, which expires in 2024.

#### D. ESTABLISH A QUORUM

Mr. Pierman determined that the attendance of Chairperson Dyanna Jordan, Vice Chairman Ryan Hagen and Supervisors Carlos Maymi and Joe Cruise constituted a quorum and it was in order to proceed with the meeting.

Also present was District Manager Jason Pierman of Special District Services, Inc.

A **motion** was made by Mr. Hepke, seconded by Mrs. Hepke and unanimously passed ratifying all actions of the Board prior to a quorum being installed.

#### E. ADDITIONS OR DELETIONS TO THE AGENDA

Mr. Pierman explained that, now that a new Board had been installed, it was necessary to elect officers. Following a brief discussion, a **motion** was made by Mr. Maymi, seconded by Mr. Cruise, and unanimously passed electing the following slate of officers:

#### F. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC FOR ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA

There were no comments from the public for items not on the agenda.

#### G. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. May 1, 2024, Regular Board Meeting

Mr. Pierman presented the minutes of the May 1, 2024, Regular Board Meeting and asked if there were any changes/corrections.

A **motion** was made by Mr. Maymi, seconded by Ms. Jordan and passed unanimously approving the minutes of the May 1, 2024, Regular Board Meeting, as presented.

#### H. OLD BUSINESS

There were no Old Business items to come before the Board.

#### I. NEW BUSINESS

1. Consider Resolution No. 2024-02 – Resetting the Public Hearing to Adopt a Fiscal Year 2024/2025 Final Budget

Resolution No. 2024-02 was presented, entitled:

#### **RESOLUTION NO. 2024-02**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE PRINCIPAL ONE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT AMENDING RESOLUTION NO. 2024-01; AMENDING THE DATE AND TIME FOR THE PUBLIC HEARING TO CONSIDER THE FISCAL YEAR 2024/2025 FINAL BUDGET AND ASSESSMENTS AND AUTHORIZING THE SECRETARY AND DISTRICT MANAGER TO TAKE CERTAIN ACTIONS TO ACCOMPLISH THE INTENT OF THIS RESOLUTION; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Pierman noted that the District was late in adopting the Final Budget, due to the lack of quorum, but that it must be adopted at a Public Hearing. He explained that, in order for the District to collect assessments, staff had provided the County with assessment amounts from the Proposed Budget because

the deadline for submitting the tax roll was in September. Although the assessment amounts have already reported, the Board still needs to hold the Public Hearing to formally adopt the Final Budget.

A **motion** was made by Mr. Cruise, seconded by Mr. Maymi and passed unanimously adopting Resolution No. 2024-02, as presented, setting the Public Hearing for December 4, 2024, at 6:00 p.m.

2. Consider Resolution No. 2024-03 – Ratifying Fiscal Year 2024/2025 Meeting Schedule

Resolution No. 2024-03 was presented, entitled:

#### **RESOLUTION NO. 2024-03**

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE PRINCIPAL ONE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT, ESTABLISHING A REGULAR MEETING SCHEDULE FOR FISCAL YEAR 2024/2025 AND SETTING THE TIME AND LOCATION OF SAID DISTRICT MEETINGS; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

A **motion** was made by Mr. Maymi, seconded by Mr. Cruise and passed unanimously adopting Resolution No. 2024-04, as presented.

4. Consider Resolution No. 2024-05 – Adopting a Fiscal Year 2023/2024 Amended Budget

#### 5. Consider Selection of Professional Engineering Services

#### 6. Consider Appointment of Audit Committee & Approval of Evaluation Criteria

Mr. Pierman explained that, at this time, it was in order for the Board to convene as the Auditor Selection Committee to review the results of the auditor selection criteria from the responding firms.

Mr. Pierman noted that Grau & Associates was the only proposal.

A motion was made by Ms. Jordan, seconded by Mr. Maymi and unanimously passed recommending Grau & Associates, and closing the Auditor Selection Committee Meeting and resuming the Regular Board Meeting.

Sitting as the Board, a **motion** was made by Mr. Maymi, seconded by Ms. Jordan and unanimously passed accepting the recommendation of the Auditor Selection Committee and directing staff to enter into negotiations with Grau & Associates.
