PRINCIPAL ONE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT REGULAR BOARD MEETING MAY 7, 2025

A. CALL TO ORDER

District Manager Jason Pierman called the May 7, 2025, Regular Board Meeting of the Principal One Community Development District (the "District") to order at 6:07 p.m. in the Clubhouse of Il Villagio located at 9745 Touchton Road, Jacksonville, Florida 32246.

B. PROOF OF PUBLICATION

Mr. Pierman presented proof of publication that notice of the Regular Board Meeting had been published in the *Jacksonville Daily Record* on September 19, 2024, as part of the District's Fiscal Year 2024/2025 Meeting Schedule, as legally required.

C. CONSIDER RESIGNATION AND APPOINTMENT TO BOARD VACANCY

Mr. Pierman presented Mr. Cruise's resignation from the Seat 3 of the Board of Supervisors. A **motion** was made by Ms. Jordan, seconded by Mr. Maymi and unanimously passed accepting Mr. Cruise's resignation.

D. ESTABLISH A QUORUM

Mr. Pierman determined that the attendance of Chairperson Dyanna Jordan, Vice Chairman Ryan Hagen and Supervisor Carlos Maymi constituted a quorum and it was in order to proceed with the meeting.

Also present were District Manager Jason Pierman of Special District Services, Inc.; Joe Cruise, the Association Liaison; Christian Crawford, Il Villagio Association Manager and District resident Javier (last name unknown).

E. ADDITIONS OR DELETIONS TO THE AGENDA

Mr. Pierman noted that the proposal from Advantage Plumbing would be added under New Business.

F. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC FOR ITEMS NOT ON THE AGENDA

There were no comments from the public for items not on the agenda.

G. APPROVAL OF MINUTES

1. December 4, 2024, Public Hearing & Regular Board Meeting

Mr. Pierman presented the minutes of the December 4, 2024, Public Hearing & Regular Board Meeting and asked if there were any changes/corrections.

A **motion** was made by Ms. Jordan, seconded by Mr. Hagen and passed unanimously approving the minutes of the December 4, 2024, Public Hearing & Regular Board Meeting, as presented.

H. OLD BUSINESS

There were no Old Business items to come before the Board.

I. NEW BUSINESS

1. Consider Maintenance Agreement with Il Villagio Association

Mr. Pierman presented the agreement, noting that it was much broader than the agreement previously in place with the Association. Following a lengthy discussion, a **motion** was made by Mr. Hagen, seconded by Mr. Maymi and unanimously passed approving the agreement, subject to the Chair's and legal's review of any Association recommendations.

2. Discussion Regarding Landscaping Improvements

Mr. Cruise explained that the Association's landscape committee had made suggestions for the front landscaping. Following discussion, a **motion** was made by Ms. Jordan, seconded by Mr. Maymi and unanimously passed authorizing a not-to-exceed amount of \$8,000 for Association-requested landscape improvements.

3. Consider Pressure Washing Proposal

Following a brief discussion, the Board consensus was to wait on pressure cleaning.

4. Consider Resolution No. 2025-01 – Adopting a Fiscal Year 2025/2026 Proposed Budget

Mr. Pierman presented Resolution No. 2025-01, entitled:

RESOLUTION NO. 2025-01

A RESOLUTION OF THE BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE PRINCIPAL ONE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT APPROVING A PROPOSED BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2025/2026; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

Mr. Pierman explained that the Board could lower assessments at the public hearing if the Association takes over maintenance. The possibility of televising the drainage lines was discussed, noting that there had been a few sinkhole issues throughout the community. Following discussion, a **motion** was made by Ms. Jordan, seconded by Mr. Hagen and unanimously passed adopting Resolution 2025-01 and setting the Public Hearing for August 6, 2025.

J. AUDITOR SELECTION COMMITTEE

1. Ranking of Proposals/Consider Selection of an Auditor

Mr. Pierman explained that, at this time, it was in order for the Board to convene as the Auditor Selection Committee to review the results of the auditor selection criteria from the responding firms.

Mr. Pierman noted that Grau & Associates was the only proposal received. A **motion** was made by Mr. Maymi, seconded by Mr. Hagen and unanimously passed recommending Grau & Associates, and to recess the Auditor Selection Committee and resume the Regular Board Meeting.

Sitting as the Board, a **motion** was made by Mr. Maymi, seconded by Mr. Hagen and unanimously passed accepting the recommendation of the Auditor Selection Committee and directing staff to enter into negotiations with Grau & Associates.

K. ADMINISTRATIVE MATTERS

Mr. Pierman reminded the Board to be on the lookout for the Form 1 email sometime in the next few weeks and noted that the next meeting would be held on August 6^{th} .

L. BOARD MEMBER COMMENTS

There were no further comments from the Board Members.
